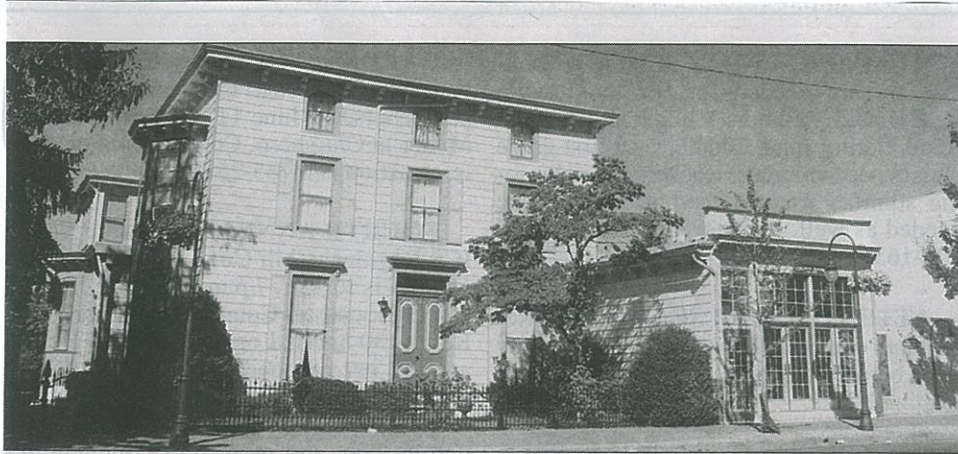

## Family Center Hosting Mansion Tour

**MILLVILLE** — The Holly City Family Center is hosting tours of the 148-year-old Wheaton Mansion.

Located at 516-518 N. High Street, the mansion will open its doors to the public between 1 & 9 p.m. next Wednesday, June 17. Entrance fee is \$5 per person at the door. The fee includes a take-home information booklet. Coffee and tea will be offered, with baked goods available for sale.

According to a Family Center spokesperson, visitors will experience the grandeur of the past as they explore three floors of the meticulously-restored example of a Victorian era homestead.

The Millville landmark was at one time a residence of the T.C. Wheaton family. The home features original hardwood floors, chandeliers and imported antiques. Tour

guides will be stationed on each floor to provide information.

In homage to the era, visitors are being invited to visit dressed in Victorian costume. Contestants will be judged by staff throughout the day. Three top prizes will be awarded at the end of the day with winners subsequently notified.

Proceeds from this special opening of the home will support the Holly City Family Center, the nearby recreation and fitness facility at 8 E. Mulberry St. off Buck Street.

The Family Center includes a swimming pool, tanning beds, modern cardio equipment, exercise classes, strength training, massage therapy and even nutrition programs.
