



Error kept families off list for housing

MILLVILLE -- Disabled adults with children can still apply to live at the Maurice View Plaza.

Millville Housing Authority Executive Director Paul Dice said Tuesday he discovered about eight applicants were incorrectly denied a place on the authority's waiting list for the East Vine Street complex.

The complex for disabled adults between 18 and 49 has 30 units and a few vacancies that Dice hopes to fill within a few weeks.


The applicants who were denied had children, but Dice said Tuesday the authority cannot restrict housing to anyone based on their family situation.

Dice met with the employees Tuesday to discuss the error and said a new procedure will be put in place to provide more oversight over the application process.

Dice encouraged people who were denied to reapply. The MHA's waiting list for Maurice View is open through Oct. 31.
