» A quote by Councilman Doug Albrecht in a front-page story Saturday was taken out of context. Albrecht was referring to Vineland Municipal Electric Utility's plan to charge commercial solar-field businesses a fee to connect to the utility's grid structure when he said: "This is so that we, the consumers or customers of the city's electric utility system, don't front the cost of this. They pay for using our system to get to the grid, by doing this and setting the pattern that other utilities look at, we recoup the cost."

Additionally, the headline and story incorrectly reported private solar-panel users could face an additional fee from the utility. The VMEU is studying a decoupling rate plan which would increase the flat rate customer charge while decreasing the energy charge. The flat rate customer charge would be billed to all customers, regardless of whether they have solar panels. The effect, however, would be that solar customers could pay more to the utility each month. The average non-solar customer likely would not see a higher bill as a result, the utility said.

» A change in monthly membership rates for Holly City Family Center in a story Monday was incorrect. The current rate covering a family for a month is \$54.25. The new rate will be \$56.
