MHA Recalls Denied Applications for Housing for Young Disabled Persons with Children

August 31, 2010, MILLVILLE, NJ - The Millville Housing Authority is recalling a small number of applications for residence at its Maurice View Plaza facility located at 1 East Vine St, Millville, NJ that were recently and mistakenly denied.

Paul Dice, MHA Executive Director, stated, "Due to clerical error, a few applications were denied and returned to potential residents with children solely on the basis that the Maurice View Plaza is for disabled young adults."

According to Dice, "The MHA does not deny residency on the basis of familial status. Disabled people with children are welcome to make application...What happened was a mistake. The MHA will correct that mistake and ensure that all applicants are treated fairly."
